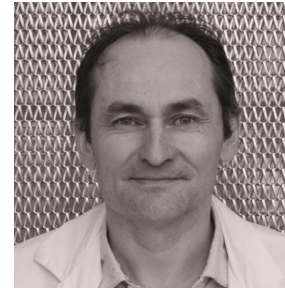

- Population Health can be addressed by the many digital footprints that we leave.



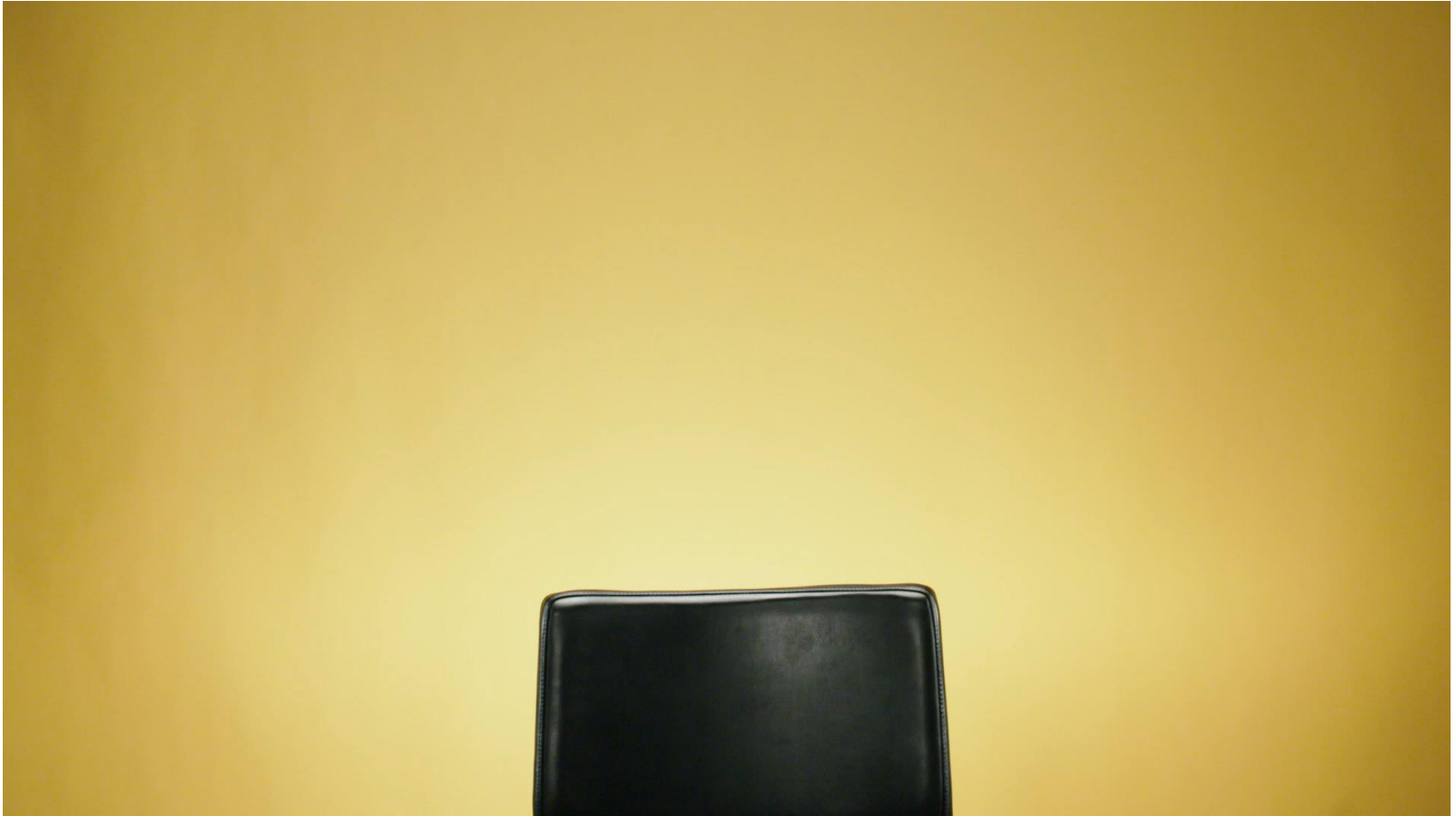
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- Automation requires the collection of large amounts of data from many different sources, the issue around data protection is not yet fully solved.
